We are here as part of the America Forward Coalition, a network of over 100 social innovation organizations that champion innovative, effective, and efficient solutions to our country's most pressing social problems.

We are here today participating in America Forward's Virtual Fiscal Year 2022 Appropriations Week. The America Forward FY22 appropriations letter outlines our collective vision for how to support communities as we go from crisis to recovery.

While we support all of these priorities, today, we would like to specifically highlight several areas, mentioned in the letter, for which funding is critical in advancing the work we do [supporting students with X needs, for e.g.] and share with you the importance of [increased/sustained] funding for these programs...



A Refresher on Our Collective Letter

Our <u>FY22 Appropriations request letter</u> centers around our priorities for federal funding in Education, Workforce, National Service and other programs important to our Coalition.

Highlights include:

- Early childhood: Builds on Funding in American Rescue Plan for Child Care and Head Start
- K-12: Supports White House \$20 Billion increase for Title I, plus billions more for Teachers, Whole Learner Initiatives, School Innovation, After School Programs, and Special Education
- **Higher Education**: Calls for \$400 increase for the maximum Pell Grant
- Workforce: Supports the American Jobs Plan for Workforce Investments, plus increases for YouthBuild and Community College Training Grants
- **National Service**: Supports the expansion of the number of service members and the increase of equitable access to service opportunities and service providers
- **Evidence:** Calls for Congress to focus funding on programs that are evidence-based and reward those that work

- Opportunity to Tweak Your Story (3 min)


