- 1) Share who you are / who your organization is.
- Point a picture of the people or communities you serve.
- Be specific about the challenges you face and demonstrate the need for and impact of your work facusing on advancing your organization's goals and American Ferward's callective priorities.

Meetings with Staffers or Members?

Our Recommendation:

- Meet with the staffer(s).
- Staffers are your best option as you will be able to have a longer, more substantive meeting - and the most feasible option at this unique time.
- It is harder to set up a meeting with Members (and to have that meeting last more than 5-10 minutes).





How Many Meetings to Aim For?

- No hard and fast rule will depend on your team's capacity / availability as well as that of Hill staff.
- We have found virtual meetings are very efficient and focused, so very possible to do multiple in a day.
- Your whole team does not have to be on the same call - can split up team to divide and conquer.
- While most conversations will be 30 minutes, sometimes they will run over - so please schedule buffer time. We would not recommend scheduling multiple meetings back to back.





How to Reach out? Timing?

- By Email!
- Our suggestion on timing would be to make the initial outreach 2-3 weeks ahead of time (and not earlier than that)
 - So our time held today is great timing!
- If you have not heard back in a few days, definitely follow up!





What to Include in Meeting Request?

- A greeting!
- Your name, title, organization name and a brief description of your organization
- A brief description of the America Forward Virtual FY22 Approps Hill Week
- Request to meet with the staffer to discuss the Coalition's approps asks, and x, y, z in particular
- Your team's availability (and specify in Eastern Time)
- That your team is happy to do a conference call or video call whichever works best (and happy set up if helpful)
- Brief thanks for consideration of the request
