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What is Top of Mind for Hill Staffers as You Request Meetings?

- FY23 Appropriations Bills
 - Continuing Resolutions (CRs) likely to fund government operations until after the elections
- Midterm elections—All House members and One-Third of the Senators
- COVID Funding
- Ukraine War and other International Crises
- Reconciliation Bill Re-emerge
- Student Mental Health Legislation







Hill Week Target List

America Forward's Recommendations will be drawn from:

- Your Representative and/or Senators' Offices
 - Congressional districts where your organization has presence

Among these, prioritizing:

- Those who serve on the Appropriations Committees, Labor-HHS ED Appropriations Subcommittees, the Commerce-Justice-Science Appropriations Subcommittees
- Those who serve on the Education Committees
- Those who may not be on Committees but are leaders on our issues

And, with your input:

- Members with whom you have started a relationship
- Members with whom relationships need to be created

Who Will Request Meetings?

This is a skill and relationship building opportunity!

- Rep. Virginia Foxx (R-NC)





Meetings with Staffers or Members?

Our Recommendation:

- Meet with the Staffer(s).
- Staffers are your best option as you will be able to have a longer, more substantive meeting - and the most feasible option at this unique time.
- It is harder to set up a meeting with Members (and to have that meeting last more than 5-10 minutes).





How Many Meetings to Aim For?

- No hard and fast rule
 - Will depend on your team's capacity and availability as well as that of Hill staff
- Virtual meetings prove to be the most efficient tool!
 - Presents the opportunity to have multiple meetings during the day
 - Gives you an opportunity to have a focused conversation with the staffer
- Your whole team does not have to be on the same call
 - Split up, divide and conquer!
- Hill staff meetings are scheduled to be 30 minutes long but they can run over.
 - Schedule buffer time
 - We would not recommend scheduling multiple meetings back-to-back







How to Reach out? Timing?

- By Email
- Make the initial outreach 2-3 weeks ahead of time (and not earlier than that)
- If you have not heard back in a few days, send a follow up email





What to Include in Meeting Request?

- A greeting
- Your name, title, organization name and a brief description of your organization
- A brief description of the America Forward Virtual FY23
 Approps Hill Week
- Mention the purpose of the meeting: to discuss the Coalition's approps asks
- Share your team's availability and specify the timezone (Eastern)
- Mention that your team is happy to do a conference call or video call; whichever works best (and happy to set up if helpful)
- Brief "thanks" for consideration of the request
